begin2ride (B2R) Recognized Instructor (02.14.09)

An NMT B2R recognized instructor is, at a minimum, one who:

- Currently owns and operates a motorcycle;
or has previously owned and operated a motorcycle for a minimum of one year
and a minimum riding of 1000 miles.
- Is a licensed motorcyclist, and has never had motorcycle licensed suspended or
revoked.

and

- Has a high school diploma or equivalent
- Has certified in adult CPR and First Aid within the previous two years.
- Is a current employee of an B2R program provider.

and

- Has completed an NMT B2R instructor preparation course of study,
or acceptable substitute.
- Is committed to educational principles of guided discovery.
- Has been evaluated, and approved, by an NMT instructor trainer,
for the recognition as an NMT B2R instructor.
